How Are You Doing with Your One? Is there something holding you back from inviting your one to Worship on September 11? This is the fifteenth anniversary of September 11, 2001. We are anticipating a Sunday filled with hope on this September 11th. You can invite someone into a community of hope in Christ Jesus. Think about inviting that one person, which God leads you to invite to church. I'm sure God will guide you in this if you take a few minutes to pray about who you might invite. We are asking everyone to invite their One. Imagine all of those "Ones" showing up on Sunday, September 11. What a great Sunday it will be. So, invite your One!

Refinishing the Church Pews. We are in the process of refinishing the pews in the sanctuary/worship center. It's going along, 2-4 pews a week. The refinisher is doing this right in the sanctuary so on a Sunday you might smell a little varnish, but so far it's been fine by Sunday as he works in the beginning of the week. He is doing the fronts (seat & backs) and back of the pew first. You can see the envelope and hymnal racks are off the backside of the pews as he takes them to his shop. Once the backs and fronts of the pews are finished, he will start all of the ends and replace veneer where that is needed. He is staining to match the existing color and finishing with satin varnish, so you will not see a high glossed pew. But you can see the difference between the refinished pews and the pews that need his work. We will also look into getting new pew pads as well. We are waiting on bids on the pew pads. The refinishing of all the pews is \$30,459. If you would like to contribute to this project, just mark your envelope or check "pew refinishing."
