

Mission Trip Application Leech Lake, MN June 25-July 1, 2017

This year we will again be working with YouthWorks. We have had a great experience with them the past several years last year; they do a great job encouraging both service and spiritual growth. As you think and pray about your child's participation this summer, you can go to www.youthworks.com to get a feel for the organization.

Where are we going?

We are heading to Minnesota, about 8 hours from Joliet. The Leech Lake Reservation (Cass Lake) of north central Minnesota is surrounded by the Chippewa National Forest. The actual lake of Cass Lake surrounds Star Island, which encircles it's own spring-fed lake, Lake Windigo, within it. There are only a few other lakes-within-lakes in the northern hemisphere! Cass Lake is the tribal headquarters for the Leech Lake Reservation, which is a part of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe. The Minnesota Chippewa Tribe is a federally recognized government that provides resources and support to the six reservations under its umbrella.

What will they be doing?

It's a similar format to other YouthWork trips we've done in the past (e.g. Atlanta and Toronto), but different from the labor intensive worksites of Mingo County, West Virginia where we served last year. We may:

- Serve through painting, cleaning, yard work, simple work projects or upkeep of community gardens.
- Plan and lead kids programming for children, including Bible lessons, games, crafts and reading.
- Assist with the local school's initiative to teach Ojibwe language and culture to community children.
- Plan and facilitate sports-based programming for community youth.

To best meet the needs of the community and build stronger relationships, students will generally serve at just one site throughout the week. Groups will meet a host of different community friends with unique backgrounds and rich stories about the Leech Lake area. In the evenings you will have the opportunity to visit Norway Beach in the Chippewa National Forest, learn about Native American culture and spirituality from an Ojibwa perspective, participate in a scavenger hunt around Cass Lake and experience a community cookout which sometimes includes drummers and dancers.

Who's eligible? Students who are Freshmen – Seniors

What is the financial commitment?

Families are asked to **contribute \$275 per student.** This is a reduced cost from the actual per student cost of the trip.

When is the deadline for applying?

YouthWorks has given us a lot of grace in the transition, but we still need applications in by **Sunday, February 15**th with a **deposit of \$50**. Late applications will be accepted, but a spot is not guaranteed and the applicant will be liable for any extra costs incurred through YouthWorks.
