Worship This Sunday

We are focusing on the life, ministry, and person of Jesus each Sunday in our "Look to Jesus" Sermon series. We are using our S.E.R.V.A.N.T.(S.) values as we "Look to Jesus," that is Spirit-Filled, Empathy, Visibly Seeking Out, All Together, Nearing God, Teaching, and Submission.

Fifteen years ago, seven individuals from First Pres. (only 2 of us remain) read through and prayed over the entire New Testament to develop a set of core values that would capture and foster our passion and conviction as a community of faith that serves Jesus Christ. These values, known by the acronym S.E.R.V.A.N.T.S., adorn the walls of our sanctuary, but, the question is simple...are they just decorations or are they something we really believe? This Sunday we encounter the value of "Nearing God," and while it is easy to understand that prayer life and study of the Bible are two ways we near God, there is a third way through our interactions with others. The sermon text from Mark 11:1-11 provides a most appropriate Palm Sunday foundation as well as a deeper look into what it means to near God in our daily lives with others in my sermon titled, "Why are you doing this?" --Dale Ambler
