Worship This Sunday

The Week Ahead

Worship and Celebrate what God is doing in the World, in your Church, and in your Life this Sunday. I encourage you to prepare for worship by praying to see and understand what God is doing in our world, in our church, and in our lives this week. Read Psalm 136 and consider the breadth, width, height and scope of God's enduring love. Consider how God set his people free and swept evil oppressors away. Let's pray for the suffering people of Manchester and pray for protection from evil. Let's pray for our enemies that God would change their hearts and bring them to faith in Christ Jesus, just as the Lord stopped Paul from being an evil oppressor and brought him to faith. Paul, who inflected much suffering on Christians, would live for Christ and suffer greatly for his Savior, even being executed for his faith. Let us pray that the love of God would flow from us to others wherever we go.

**Sunday, May 28**. This Sunday Jim Mullins is preaching on "Spring Cleaning or Emptiness is not Godliness." The sermon texts are Matthew 12:43-45 and Psalm 136. For the context of Matthew 12:43-45 you should read the beginning of the chapter, Matthew 12:1-42. Jesus is receiving biting, misguided, and evil criticism from the Pharisees and Teachers of the law. They wish to get rid of Jesus. However, Jesus is not so easily dismissed.





## Selfie Challenge

"Who is that?" — "What's their name?"...the list of 'I don't know who that is' questions is long and it's time to turn it around. Just because you don't know someone as well as your best friend or family member shouldn't stop you from getting to know those you don't know at church. Parish Council wants to make it easy for you to get to know someone new and it is as simple as asking really easy ice breaker questions like: Cubs or Sox? What's your favorite holiday? Favorite season? Favorite movie? You get the idea...so here are 3 easy steps:

- Find someone new...seek them out—Introduce yourself and be intentional and admit you don't know who they are but really would like to get to know something about them.
