Living Faith: "Faith Beyond the Creed" Series, We have started a journey to look at people of faith in the Bible that were transformed by God's compassion, grace, and strength. What does faith look like in real life? How do we live out, in our day and time, the foundational beliefs we studied and confessed in the Apostles' Creed Series? Come and worship with us as we seek to live our faith and put into practice the love, hope, joy, and purposes of Jesus Christ.

Sunday, August 6, I am preaching on "Jonah: The Runaway Servant." The sermon passages are from Jonah 1:1-3, 3:1-5, 8-10, 4:1-3; Matthew 9:9-13, and I Timothy 2:1-6. Jonah, knowing what God wants him to do, runs away in the opposite direction. He absolutely doesn't want to do what God wants. But God doesn't give up on Jonah. Despite his outright disobedience, God still uses Jonah to serve him in an amazing way. Sometimes, that's good to know.
