“Faith First” Series Begins This Sunday! What if faith was our first response in life? What if we lived each moment, each day of life out of faith in Christ Jesus? What does the faithful life as a follower of Jesus mean for us, individually and as a congregation? Over the next eight weeks we will explore how we can be “Faith First” Followers of Jesus.

Sunday, September 10. I am preaching on “Faith First: Faith As Response” this Sunday. The scripture passages for the sermon and worship are: Ephesians 1:15-23, Luke 7:1-10, and James 1:27. Paul gives thanks for the faith he sees in the Ephesian Church. Luke shares the story of one centurion who acts in faith, in such a way that he inspires Jesus. James informs us that a true expression of faith is to “look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.”
