We surpassed our goal and packed 116,640 meals (540 boxes), which will feed 319 children for an entire year. Mission Council gives a special thanks to everyone who helped make this a great and meaningful event: all those who helped to organize, welcome, register, set up, clean up, pack and label food, or provide financial support.
