The music ministry at First Presbyterian Joliet is open to all who need a place to lend their voice or share their instrumental talents to support our worship experience. Your desire to participate is all we require for you to join us.



**Chancel Choir** – Chancel Choir is open to singers of high school age and older. Chancel Choir provides music for one of our morning services each week and for special celebrations throughout the year. Special performances include seasonal cantatas and extended choral programs in both morning and evening services. We meet on Wednesday nights from 7:30 until 9:00 p.m. in Room 208 to rehearse. **Glory Ringers** – This choir welcomes people with some musical experience who would enjoy ringing bells as part of a handbell choir. Performing twice a month, this group rehearses on Monday nights at 7:00 p.m., beginning September 13, in the narthex. See Paula Stimpert, Glory Ringers Director.



**Youth Choir** – This choir is made up of members in our Jr. and Sr. High Youth program. They share songs of faith with the congregation several times a year and rehearse as part of the youth ministry program. See Heather Rey, Director of Youth Ministry.

**Choristers Choir** – Choristers involve boys and girls from 2<sup>nd</sup> grade through 5<sup>th</sup> grade. They sing once a month in worship, for special occasions, and are part of a musical once a year. This group meets at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday nights as part of the Zoom family program. **Cherub Choir** – Cherubs involve boys and girls from 4 years old through 1<sup>st</sup> grade. They sing once a month in worship, for special occasions, and are part of a musical once a year. **Women's Chorus** – Women's Chorus is open to all women in the church who wish to participate in 2-3 part women's choral music. This group meets 2-3 weeks in advance of a performance from 7:00 – 7:45 p.m. on Wednesday evenings in Room 208 and performs 4 or 5 times a year. See Ken Myers.

**Men's Chorus** – Men's Chorus is open to all men in the church who wish to participate in 4 part men's choral music.
