A little over 2000 years ago a group of Jesus' followers lined a road leading to Jerusalem, shouting "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!" Joyful praise for sure, but I also think it was a form of public prayer as the meaning of "Hosanna" is literally, "save us." Those lining the road that day were looking for a certain kind of savior—one who would end the tyranny and oppression of the Roman Empire. Many pray for a similar result today. This Sunday we continue our Sermon on the Mount series by looking at Matthew 7:7-11 and ask ourselves the question, "Prayer: Does It Make A Difference?"
