We are exploring the possibility of a Verizon Booster Cell Antennae Site at the church. The Stewardship Council with the guidance of the Session has been having a conversation with Verizon about adding a cell booster antennae site on the Church Bell Tower. Some equipment would be housed on the top of back side of the Hoffman Hall roof. Cell antennae would be added to the Bell Tower and the Bell Tower would be made 10 feet taller. This Sunday you can see pictures and plans on a table in the Narthex area and on a table in Hoffman Hall. This is a long process and we have not yet agreed to a lease with Verizon. We are in the discussion stages. Verizon is submitting a plan for permitting the project to the City of Joliet should we decide to move forward with the project. However, at this time we are not in agreement on the draft lease proposal. Please take a look at the plans and let us know what you think.
