



"The Gospel of Mark" Summer Sermon Series

Over the summer, until September 1, we are going through a 14-week study of the Gospel of Mark. I encourage you to start reading the Gospel of Mark, the shortest Gospel, in preparation for our Sermon Study and throughout the summer. Most weeks you can read one chapter and come prepared for the Sunday morning Sermon and worship.

- July 7 "I Quit Being Fearful to Follow" Mark 6:45-56
- July 14 Mark 7

I am preaching this Sunday on "I Quit Being Fearful to Follow." The sermon text is from Mark's Gospel 6:45-56. Chapter 6 shows us how the disciples expand their understanding of who Jesus is and overcome their fears to follow him, as they are challenged in ministry situations. Jesus takes the disciples to his home town and encounters great unbelief and criticism, then he sends the twelve out, two by two, to do ministry on their own, John the Baptist is beheaded, the 5,000 are fed by Jesus after the disciples tell him to send the people away, and finally Jesus walks on water to the disciples who are in a boat on the Sea of Galilee and they were terrified and afraid. We see the disciples challenged and needing to face their fears to follow Jesus. It's a good passage for our time.
