I encourage you to start reading the Gospel of Mark, the shortest Gospel, in preparation for our Sermon Study each week. On most weeks you can read one chapter and come prepared for the Sunday morning Sermon and worship. However, the final several weeks we will be choosing texts from two chapters.

August 18 "Choose to Love" Mark 12:28-34

August 25 "Choose to Prepare"
Mark 13:32-36; 14:12-16

September 1 Mark 15-16

This Sunday, I am preaching on "Choose to Love" from Mark 12:28-34. This is one of Jesus' most remembered teachings on how we should live. Jesus taught we should love God and love our neighbor. I think of Mark Twain's remarks, "It ain't those parts of the Bible that I can't understand that bother me, it is the parts that I do understand." it is easy for us to say that we understand we are to love God and to love our neighbor. On the other hand, it far harder to do than it is for us to understand. Join us this Sunday as we seek to live in such a way that we choose to love.


