Sunday, November 10- "Go and Do Likewise" Luke 10:35-37

Following Jesus isn't a narrow thing, something limited to Sunday morning worship. A life of discipleship is vast, wide and sacrificial, to use just a few adjectives. Luke 10:25-37 tells the story we know as "The Good Samaritan". It is a love-as-a-verb story. It's a story of acting, of doing, of caring. It's a story about being active in the lives of others, about loving our neighbor. Jesus ends the story in Luke 10:37 by saying

"Go and do likewise."

Maybe you have read this passage many times; or perhaps it will be the first time you've heard it. Either way, it's a reminder to us to extend ourselves in loving and serving others. It is a challenge to figure out what each of us, using our unique gifts and talents, are called to do.
