Sunday, March 29 "God's Will and My Identity" Luke 1:47-55

Much as changed in the world around us; God has not - he is present. Our identity is still in Jesus Christ. As Max Lucado wrote in "Anxious for Nothing", We can't run the world, but we can entrust it to God. Peace is within reach, not for lack of problems, but for the presence of a sovereign Lord. Rather than dwell on the chaos of the world, we can choose to rejoice in the Lord's sovereignty." That is what Mary did. Because she knew her identity.

Luke 1:47-55 is Mary's hymn, her song, her praise to God. In these words, we learn that Mary's life and her identity are reflections of God's work in her life. This is true of us as well. Through these words of Scripture, we are reminded that God is present with us, even in these turbulent times. Our identity is in Christ and we are God's beloved. What we do is an outflow of that.


We are living in a very different reality in the world right now.
