On Sunday, July 5 we will celebrate the Lord's Supper. We will celebrate communion in worship together at both of our Live Worship Services at 9:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. For our Live Worship services, we will use disposable elements. The bread and juice are included in a single container. You peal a lid for the bread and peal another lid for the juice. We will also celebrate communion in our Online Video Worship Service, for which you will need to supply the elements.

We Reopened last Sunday, June 28, for Live Worship at both 9:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. We had a good group at our 9 a.m. service, which meant we had to sing quietly to ourselves and could not sing out. If you want to really sing out come to the 10:30 a.m. service where we had a smaller group and could really spread out in the Sanctuary/Worship Center.

For our Live Worship Services please know that we will not have either the Nursery or Preschool areas open on Sunday for the foreseeable future. You will need to watch for those details when Ed Council determines it is safe to reopen those areas of ministry.

We will be continuing our Online Video Worship Service each week. We know that it will be a while before everyone can return to church and some won't be able to attend. For Pastoral Care please call the office to leave a message to talk with a pastor or call us on our cell phones. We are available and can access our messages from home.

Please make Reservations in order to attend Church for Live Worship. Here are a couple of things to remember for both services, 9:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. You must wear a mask and you must make reservations by e-mailing or calling the office. We need to know which service you are attending and how many are coming. Both services will be the same as we can only have between 50-70 people in the Sanctuary/ Worship Center. Please call the Church Office or send an E-mail by Friday at Noon to make a reservation.

Sunday, June 28- "Extraordinary Grace" Ephesians 2:1-10, Jeremiah 31:3, 31-34

Time is moving so fast, especially in 2020. Early this year Les, my wife, said she had a good feeling about 2020...now we laugh about that.

Then came COVID-19, Tornado/Flooding, Protests and Riots. 2020 has been a blur.

With time moving faster, we must ask, how to make the best use of the time we have. We must choose carefully, choose wisely and choose the grace of God. Each moment, day, week we must choose the kind of person we will be, what we truly want: how we will frame our life.

And God comes to us in Christ Jesus calling us to choose grace, hold on to grace.

Paul can't stop writing about it, he adds on word after word for the extraordinary, super-abounding grace in Ephesians chapter 2:1-10.

God has incredible love for us.

This is the God who is rich in mercy and makes us alive in Christ In spite of all of our fallenness, sinfulness. It's by God's grace we are saved, forgiven, made new, alive

We are raised up with Christ, as Jesus was raised from the dead so we are raised up out of selfishness, shallowness, and sinfulness God chooses to show us the Incomparable riches of his grace, in Christ Jesus, our Savior.

We are given unmerited mercy, that's grace, because God so loves.

As Jeremiah writes, God says, "I have loved you with an everlasting love."

A mother once approached Napoleon seeking a pardon for her son.

The emperor replied that the young man had committed a certain offense twice and now justice demanded his death.

"But I don't ask for justice," the mother explained. "I plead for mercy."

"But your son does not deserve mercy," Napoleon replied.

"Emperor- Sir," the woman cried, "it would not be mercy if he deserved it, and mercy is all I ask for."

"Well, then," the emperor said, "I will have mercy." And he spared the woman's son.

And so God, in and through Paul says, I will have mercy. Choose grace.

Choose to live in my grace and extend my grace to others.
