## Sunday July 12, 2020 "A Grace that Unites" Ephesians 3:1-13

A Grace that Unites. - In Ephesians 3:1-13 Paul speaks about his Identity in Christ, even as he is chained to a Roman solder in prison in Rome, Paul sees that as a victory for the Gospel. Learning from Paul's circumstances, is about learning to see our lives in the light of a higher calling, as people redeemed and called to serve Christ. Our Lives are about identity, being in Christ, living out Christ. In that identity we discover that there is no more Jew or Gentile, that all are made one, and in this grace we are called to serve those around us. So, do you know who you are? Do you know who you are in Christ? You are redeemed, called to love, called to serve called to be part of that grace that unites.
