Summer Sermon Series "Essential Faith, Extraordinary Grace"

The book of Ephesians, written to a group of churches, expresses the width and breadth and length of God's love and grace. It describes the importance of the Church and why the Body of Christ exists and how it services and does ministry in the world. Paul indicates how the Church crosses racial boundaries and social classes for all are one in Christ Jesus. There's even more to this wonderful book and letter of the Apostle Paul. Sunday, July 26 "One and Many" Ephesians 4:1-16

Christians do not need to agree on everything to have unity, we need to live the unity of a common commitment to Jesus.

The reality is that we live in a time where opinions are strong. As Christians, even amid diverse thoughts on the current culture, we are called to live in harmony with one another. Not agreeing on every little thing, but focusing our minds and hearts on Christ and His church. Paul's words in Ephesians 4:1-16 clearly tell us that there is one body, one spirit, one hope, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, and one God and Father. He goes on to remind us that the one church body is made up of many parts - some apostles, some prophets, some evangelists and some pastors and teachers. The same Spirit works in all Christians. Together, we work to build the church. We each have an important role to live out.

Church has changed, at least temporarily if not long term. This is an exciting time to be a person of faith. We have so much love to share with a world that is badly bruised - the love of Christ, and the love we are called to have for people. As different as everything seems, the church is still one body, made of many parts. We are each blessed to be one of those many parts. The church's method may have shifted, but the message is the same. The gospel is timeless.

Ephesians 4:1-16 is densely rich with words of direction and words of hope. In this passage, Paul reminds us that Christian living consists of truth, love and continual growth into Christ.

I'm really excited to gather with you this weekend, either in person or online. Peace be with each and every one of you!
