Sunday, August 16 "Relationships and Submission" Ephesians 5:21-33

Chapter 5 begins with the call to "Follow God's example" (NIV) or "Be imitators of God" (RSV) and to live differently in Christ than the typical way of living espoused in the Greco-Roman world. Now in Ephesians 5:21 we started a section on relationships. The key, as Paul writes here, is to "Submit to one another out of reverence to Christ." This is a call to mutual submission and conciliation in relationships, the first of which is the marriage relationship. Yet we are also being taught about Christ's relationship with his church in these verses.
