### New Two-Part Sermon Series

#### “Trust and Thanksgiving In Turbulent Times”

We continue a new two-week series as we enter the Thanksgiving Season. The focus is on trusting the Lord for all things and times as well as living in gratitude to God.

Jeremiah teaches us to live in faith and to trust God. We read, “But blessed are those who trust in the Lord.”

We are also reminded in the scriptures to “Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good.” (Psalm 136:1) Over the next two weeks we will explore what it means to live in trust and to live into thanksgiving.

#### Sunday, November 22, “How Can We Give Thanks?” Isaiah 11:1-11, Romans 8:31-39, I Thessalonians 5:16-18

How can we give thanks in the difficult and challenging times, in which we live? We can remind ourselves of God’s great love, justice, and plan for all the world, which we find revealed in Isaiah 11:1-11. We can remember that “in all things God works for good,” which we read in Romans 8:28 and that “nothing can separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus,” which we see in Romans 8:38-39. Then we can give deeper thought about what it means “to give thanks in all circumstances” but not for all circumstances. I encourage you to read I Thessalonians 5:16-18 for several days this week as you prepare for Thanksgiving.

The Worship service is available on Saturday evenings and remains online for you to Worship at the best time for you.

**Interim Pastor Search Committee** plans are coming together. The Session has decided to have the HR Council invite 2-3 congregational members to join HR in forming the search committee for an Interim Pastor. The goal is to have an Interim Pastor ready to start serving at First Pres the beginning of May, as I am retiring on May 1. Please pray for HR and the additional members they will add to form the search committee.

## **Sunday, November 15 "Trust Amidst Turmoil" Psalm 20:1-9, Jeremiah 17:7-8, Mark 9:14-24**

I invite you to think with me more deeply about the significance of trust. I would submit to you that Trust is necessary for our day-to-day life. Living in distrust will dramatically alter our lives.

Whenever we drive somewhere: church, going home; we trust stop signs we trust traffic lights will be obeyed; people will stay in their lanes...

If you decide to purchase anything this week, you trust it works.

I needed a new shaver, paid my money, went home and it shaves or if it didn't I could exchange it for another one or get money back.

Online purchases continue growing each and every year; huge in this pandemic. When you choose a product, book, purse, shirt shoes, or whatever; you provide your credit card and you trust that the item will be mailed to you, you trust that it will work, you trust that your credit card number will be used once, and you trust that no one else will be given your credit card number. If you need to go to the bank or credit union this week you trust that your money is going to be there.

We all know special people in our lives who say yes, I'll do this or that, and they always come through.

We are grateful that we can count on them.

I hope you have some "always come-through people" in your life.

Right now, in our climate of political polarization and contentiousness a lot of people are living in the land of distrust and skepticism. The land of distrust is a most disconcerting place to try to live.

Thank God for those always come-through people in our lives, whom we trust.

If we trust other people how much better and greater is it to trust in God.

There are benefits for Trusting in God. Here are four benefits that flow to us.

**Perplexing Anxiety**, freedom from such anxiety and rest for one's spirit.

**Prayers** are worth praying for the Lord wants to answer.

**Provision**; we have a God who provides.

**Presence**; we live in the presence of God who is good.

Blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord, whose confidence is in him.

Trust is blessed by God, and Blessed means a deep and abiding joy a sense of strength, meaning, and happiness rooted in the Lord.

May you know the blessedness of trusting in the Lord God.
