

"Team Jesus: Who are You in the Church?" Sermon Series

In this series we will think about all of the various kinds of people we need to be the church today. We need those who depend upon the Good Shepherd. We need people who will provide resources, act on their faith, and show appreciation. The church needs servants who will stand with those in need no matter how difficult the situation. We need members who will teach and mentor others, and more. During the Lenten Season as we anticipate Easter, we will look at those who followed Jesus in the New Testament and see what we can learn about ourselves and about the Church of Jesus Christ.

#### Palm Sunday, March 28 "Someone who Shows Appreciation: the Leper" Luke17:11-19; Mark 11:1-11

On Palm Sunday we think of the crowds who shouted out their praises and hosannas to Jesus. The people genuinely honor and praise Jesus. This is a different crowd than the one, which was organized by the chief priests, elders and teachers of the law to shout out crucify him to Pilate, very early on the morning of Good Friday. The crowd on Palm Sunday shows their appreciation of Jesus as he rides into Jerusalem. We also see true appreciation of Jesus from the one Leper who was healed and returned to praise God and offer thanksgiving. We will think about the value of appreciation as we worship together on this Palm Sunday.

#### Sunday, March 21 "A Lesson About the Power of Grace: Zacchaeus" Luke 19:1-10

The encounter between Jesus and Zacchaeus is one of the most beloved stories in Sunday School. We all know the tune and how catchy that is. What stands out in this story is how grace reaches out in a powerful way.

That grace translates as acceptance and understanding. That grace opens the door for grace filled conversations that lead to change.

Transformational grace is not about a sermon, or telling people how wrong they are, transformational grace is about an invitation, where one can see who Jesus is. Too many times we forget to walk across the room and get to know people. Jesus spoke to Zaccheus and said

"I must spend time with you." I would like to encourage you to remember those words: "I must spend time with you."

People need the presence of Jesus in their lives, and the people of faith are just that. Some people need a little help to see Jesus. Let us all be people of grace, a grace that welcomes, a grace that is open for conversations, a grace that lifts people up.
