We have started a new sermon series on the book of Acts – A New Day for The Church – A new Opportunity for you. The Book of Acts, is a letter from Luke to Theophilus, and captures the life of the early church in the light of the resurrection.

Sunday, May 23rd: Pentecost

This Sunday is Pentecost Sunday. It is, really, the third major church holiday. There is Christmas, when we celebrate the birth of Christ; there is Easter, when we celebrate His resurrection; and there is Pentecost - when we commemorate the incredible arrival of the Holy Spirit. Pentecost doesn't get as much press as the other two, but it's important. Other than the Sundays in ordinary time (I absolutely LOVE just plain old regular Sundays), Pentecost is my favorite Sunday of the year. It's a huge birthday celebration for the Church.

In Acts 2:1-21, we see the unbelievable POWER of the Spirit. And in John 14:15-18, we receive comfort from Jesus as he prepares to leave the disciples and promises them they will not be alone, for the Spirit will come.

God has always had a plan, and that plan continues to unfold. We don't have Jesus walking among as like the Disciples did; but we do have the Spirit, and the Word of God. Did you know that it is the Holy Spirit that draws us to God in the first place? God, through the Spirit, gets out attention. First God loves us, then we love him. The Spirit of God says "you're mine" and we can know for certain that, through the Spirit's guidance, through Jesus' sacrifice, through God's grace and mercy, we are forgiven and free to love God and love others.

This, then, is what we will dig into together. How blessed we are. See you Sunday!

- d. Starting this week we will be moving to a Summer Worship schedule with one 9 AM Service on Sunday and continuing our online services on YouTube and Facebook. One exception to this is Sunday June 13th, when we will plan on two services 9 AM and 10:30 AM as we celebrate Pastor Craig's ministry.

I want to thank Parish council for organizing a great Movie Night last Saturday. Keep your calendars open and check for more dates for fun activities as we return to the Summer schedule. Parking Lot Dinners and more Movie Nights are in the works.

This Sunday in worship The Glory Ringers are going to lead us in worship, and Pastor Carrie will be preaching.
