A New Day for The Church – A new Opportunity for you. The Book of Acts, is a letter from Luke to Theophilus, and captures the life of the early church in the light of the resurrection.

Sunday, May 30th: Acts 10:9-18

This Sunday I am preaching on Acts 10: 9-18. This is a very important moment for the church, especially for Peter, as he sees God's plan unfolding before his eyes and opening the door of the kingdom to the gentiles. Now we know how important the purity laws were for the Jews and the believers following Jesus. The vision that Peter has, makes him question everything he believed and yet he has the presence of Spirit to be open to what the Lord is speaking to him.

This is an echo of the Old Testament: In those days I will do a new thing- I will send my Spirit to all the people. At times we too become stuck in the old ways, in the old skins of tradition and habit, and yet we know that God wants to do a new thing, that even today God continue to speak and challenge our way of thinking and being.

I hope that we can explore this passage together on Sunday.
