This Sunday we started a new sermon series on the book of Acts – A New Day for The Church – A new Opportunity for you. The Book of Acts, is a letter from Luke to Theophilus, and captures the life of the early church in the light of the resurrection.

Sunday, May 9 Bible Text Acts 1: 12-17; 21-26

Early in the book of Acts we see the disciples acting quickly in electing someone new to take Judas's **place.** As Matthias is Chosen to Replace Judas, we are given a front row seat at the inner workings of the church in Jerusalem. Leadership is important, and for the early church, that meant more than a leading person, it meant being part of a group of people dedicated and passionate about the same things. Have you wondered why it was so important to them to elect someone so quickly? I mean they were in no rush right? Soon we will see the church in Jerusalem multiply vey fast, they grow with 3,000 people after one sermon. God rewards those that prepared, I've heard that saying once or twice. The Book of Acts: A New Day for the Church, A New

Opportunity for You

The beginning of the Book of Acts captures the disciples at the time of transition and to some degree, anxiety. As Luke writes to his friend Theophilius, Luke points to some foundational themes that we will discovers as we follow the story of that little church in Jerusalem growing beyond the borders of Israel.

- **1.** Jesus is Alive this is central to all the Gospel. We worship a living God, Christ alive in the world and in us.
- 2. Remember the Message Jesus spent time with the disciples and reminded them of the message of the Kingdom of God. No matter where we are, we are messages of God's Kingdom
- **3.** Learn to listen to the Holy Spirit Jesus promised his followers the Holy Spirit, the great advocate, the Spirit of God living in us. We are called to learn to look and lean on the Spirit of God in all we do.
- 4. There is a sense of urgency in the work of the Gospel While the disciples were looking at Jesus ascending into the clouds, they are encouraged to focus on what is ahead, at that today is the best day to serve God.
