

SERMON PREVIEW RADICAL HOSPITALITY

Loving and Serving - John 13:1-17

As summer Sundays wind down, we are taking a look at hospitality -- RADICAL hospitality to be exact. The kind of hospitality that is rooted in Christ, who stands knocking on our door, waiting for us to answer so we can be in relationship with him. One of the reasons for us to think about radical hospitality is simply this: the world has changed. Like it or not, COVID-19 upset SO MANY apple carts! As we bob and weave toward whatever normal is, we have a great chance to think about our hospitality. Not because we aren't friendly and welcoming - I believe First Pres is both of those things; but rather, because there is always room for improvement. We can hone our skills and refine our hospitality tool box by looking at hospitality through the lens of our faith - because God is radical.

This Sunday we are reading a text commonly used during Maundy Thursday worship. We will read from John's gospel wherein we are reminded that Jesus, king of king and lord of lords, came not to be served but to serve with love and humility. Jesus washed his disciples' feet in a radical act of love and service. We are called to do likewise. The question we ask, and what we learn from Jesus, is how.
