

SERMON PREVIEW RADICAL HOSPITALITY

"Grace Not Grumbles" 1 Peter 4:7-11

Over the last several weeks, we have been looking at hospitality through the lens of our faith in Jesus. This hospitality, we discover, is RADICAL. It goes above and beyond, becoming as much a part of us as our breath and our faith. This week is the last sermon in the series. We will be taking a look at 1 Peter 4:7-11. Of note is verse 10, "Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms." Kind of sums up the whole series, right? Each of us should use the gifts God has given us to serve others. Gifts we have received through God's grace.

In exploring this radical hospitality thing, I found that scripture has many verses that offer clarity. Romans 12:13 reads,

"Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality."

The study notes in one of my Bibles (I LOVE study notes and other resources, by the way. The Bible comes first but we are blessed to have so many other resources at our disposal!) says that Christian hospitality is different from mere social entertaining. Entertaining focuses on the host: the home must be spotless, the food must be well prepared and abundant, the host must appear good natured and relaxed. Hospitality, by contrast, can happen in a messy home with a can of soup and chaos all around. I love that. Christian hospitality, radical hospitality, can happen anywhere, anytime. No preparation necessary, other than a heart that opens the door to Jesus' knock, love for God and neighbor, and acts of kindness as a way of life.

I'm looking forward to being with you this weekend, whether it be online or in person.
