#### Hello Dear Friends!

We have amended the Bylaws, cleaned the rolls, elected a Nominating committee and now the PNC has begun their ministry! Praise God!

My job as your Interim/Transitional minister continues as I introduce change, preach Biblically based sermons two to three times a month, attend councils, moderate the session and the meetings of the congregation, give pastoral care, visit shut ins and those in the hospital, teach Bible study, offer counseling, take part in VBS, Pancake breakfasts and Ladies events. I have just had the blessing of baptizing a family in the name of our great Triune God.

And by God's Grace, First will soon offer a night time service for those who love contemporary worship and to grow the church by attracting new people to the Lord. And always, Tim and I will continue to pray for and with the people of this incredible church. And please don't forget...

On Saturday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, at 10:00am, I will be teaching the new member class for anyone who is interested in joining the church and for anyone who would like to learn, or be reminded of, what it means to be Presbyterian. Long time members are welcome. There will be snacks!

19 children/students and 2 teachers ...Let that sink in. My heart and mind cannot fully comprehend or give the appropriate response to this tragedy. I know that I hurt. I know that my faith is asking questions I cannot answer. I know that even my most carefully thought out response or words might be causing more pain, or questions. But I also know that I am not alone in experiencing this. I know that maybe we woke up this morning saying "God! Why? Where were you yesterday?". I know that we hurt for the parents of the 19 children, for the families of the teachers, for the community around that school. And while I do not have words myself, I do want to say this: Faith is like a seed. It sometimes looks small and maybe hope is gone. Today we might be looking at another moment in time when hurt and tears make us wonder and question everything. Faith is forged in times like this. When doubt comes in, so does faith. Because of that, I pray: Lord have mercy, and help our unbelief even in times like this when we have nothing to hang on. Lord have mercy.

If you ever find yourself confused and hurting, please take time to talk with someone about that. As a pastor, I know I can listen, I can pray with you. Please reach out.

### Here's what is going on at church this week:

**1.** *Angel House* - Please check your mailbox for our monthly letter, and you will find a nice brochure about Angel House. As you read in the prayer requests, Rebecca had some health issues and was in the hospital for some blood work. Please keep praying for her health.

2. Ukraine refuge update - Last week we sent out an email update form Pastor Ovi and on Saturday I hosted a prayer meeting and update after my visit to Romania. We also discussed my conversations with the Romanian pastors that are doing the humanitarian work there. Please continue to pray for that part of the world.

**3.** *Monumental VBS - June 20-24* - Registration website should be up and running by the end of the week, as we hit a snafu on some technical issues. Please watch your email for that. Also for your calendar Volunteer Training days - June 15th at 6 pm and June 18th at 9 am. Spread the word about teenager volunteers, we need their help.

**4.** When you drive in the main parking lot you will notice a sink hole. We are working on that. In the event that the repairs are not done by Sunday morning, please plan to drive in through the alleys from Buell or Prairie, or to park across the street.

**5.** *Growth Council and Worship Council* met this past Sunday with those interested in supporting an Evening Service at First Pres. More details will be available as the team continues to shape up the vision for this great ministry opportunity.
