A Note from Pastor Bo

This Sunday I am preaching on Act 15, the first council of the church that took place in Jerusalem. As you can imagine it was not an easy time for the church. There was a lot of growth, change, and challenges to the way the first Christians were seeing their faith. In those times Peter, Paul, and Barnabas were first hand witnesses to what God was doing. While they were excited about their message and their ministry, they had to share that with the rest of the church in Jerusalem. It is important to recognize that the church as a whole, has always lived with that tension of seeing God at work in a "boots on the ground" view or hearing about it.

From my perspective that tension still exists in our own lives. We become passionate about one thing or another, about a piece of doctrine or a view on the way to minister, and when that happens we might forget those that we are called to minister to. The church in Jerusalem learned that lesson fast, that while there are different ways to do things, there is one thing that will triumph over all: Grace. Through Grace, through His forgiveness, through Christ we can do all things. I want to encourage you to come to worship on Sunday with that being your prayer: We want to see God's grace for the people around us so we can serve those that God called us to serve.

Here are a few things happening this week at church:

- The **parking lot** across the street will be under construction on Thursday. Please plan accordingly .
- Session is meeting on Thursday, and as I asked you last week please pray for this group of dedicated people that are doing so much for our faith community.
