THE PASTOR'S CORNER Roy Backus, Transitional Pastor

This year we host the Community Thanksgiving Service on Tuesday, November 22 at 7pm. Ken will meet with the choir at 6pm to rehearse for the service. This service is another sign of our moving forward after the serious distractions of COVID 19 and all. There is an addition to our shared Thanksgiving. This year we will hear three lay persons' thoughts on Thankfulness. I pray that you will mark your calendar for this ecumenical service including our church, Faith Lutheran, Westminster Presbyterian, St. John's Missionary Baptist and Joliet Jewish Congregation.

Luke 21:5-19 is the focal text for this coming Sunday. We will hear our Lord's words concerning the Temple in Jerusalem and the events to come. There are three surprising imperative verbs in this passage which continue to speak to us today. How do we respond to our Lord's directions?

Again I want to extend an invitation to the Sunday morning adult Bible study time. We meet in the Fireside Room and discuss the context and background materials within the focal text each week. This week we will discuss the Jerusalem Temple(s). How does Jesus addresses that huge immovable land mark? After 70 A.D., what took the place of the destroyed Temple? We look forward to our time together.
