A Letter from Lay Pastor Carrie Kapral

In preparation for this Sunday, I've re-watched the "Matchmaker, Matchmaker" scene from Fiddler on the Roof. I'm in the process of rewatching the entire three hour long movie - I had actually forgotten how entirely wonderful it is. A look back at Jewish tradition, preholocaust. Tradition. It is important. Bo touched on that last week, in his message. There are reasons we do what we do. Some traditions go so far back, we don't even know why we do what we do. That, I think, can become a problem.

Romans 12:2 reads, "Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is -- his good, pleasing, and perfect will."

As valuable as tradition is (and I do believe it cannot be overstated how valuable tradition is), change is also important. The time for matchmakers, in much, if not most, of the world, is long over. Times have changed. Yet, as I watch the faith on display in Fiddler on the Roof, I can't help but be reminded that we must be very careful about the reason we alter or quit a tradition. All we do is to be to the glory of God - only He can transform our minds. As times change, as the culture changes, we, as a church body, must also change. Carefully. With renewed minds, transformed by the power of God.
