PASTOR EMERITUS

On August 20, we will celebrate Pastor Craig as a Pastor Emeritus of First Presbyterian Church, Joliet. Pastor Emeritus is a honorary title given to retired pastors who are valued by the church and their community. What does a Pastor Emeritus do? This is a loose definition of the role of Pastor Emeritus.

A Pastor Emeritus is an honorary title given to a retired pastor. The title is granted by a Session and celebrated by the congregation to show honor to their retired pastor. The responsibility of leading the church belongs to the New Head of Staff Pastor and Session, but the Pastor Emeritus may be called upon at the discretion of the Head of Staff. The expectations of a Pastor Emeritus include:

- Praying for the church and its leadership.
- Assisting as invited by the Head of Staff.
- Participating in church activities and events as appropriate.
- Abstaining from interfering with the governance and administration of the church.
- Respecting the authority and decisions of the new Head of Staff Pastor and the Session.
