This is the letter which I gave to the Session on December 14, 2023.

"Session:

1)Thank you for the opportunity to serve First Presbyterian Church, Joliet. These months have been challenging and meaningful to me. I believe I've done what I can do, and the process of the church needs to continue as the Lord leads the church. My prayers will remain with you. I look forward to a less busy more focused agenda for myself.

2) My last day of work will be February 29, 2024. This will allow me to give coverage while Bo is on vacation, preparation time for the church to be led by HR with guidance from Presbytery, as well as, a reasonable determination of additional adjustments in the church's ongoing mission.

3) I do have one request for this short transitional time. I believe it is best to keep the church's focus on Advent and Christmas.
