#### A letter from Associate Pastor Bo Mircea

I want to share with you my experience with last's year morning Drop-In Imposition of Ashes, and why I would like to encourage you to stop by. Being in the quietness of the sanctuary, on a day that feels just like a work day, and yet being able to pause and meditate on the words: 'From dust to dust'. It is a reminder of your mortal condition, and yet in the same breath it is an understanding in that recognizing our mortality ,there is a grace that comes to meet us and to lift us up into the hope of Easter.
