A Letter from Lead Pastor Bo Mircea

Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise. What would your reaction be to hearing those words? The first thing I would think of for myself would be a sense of ease, a feeling of warmth and release as my worries melt away with those very words, spoken by Christ. But faith is more than "feel good" feelings. At least when you think about the cross, the conversation between Jesus and the two thieves, you are challenged to focus on the response as being the most important part of that dialog. It is not necessarily how you feel, but how you respond to the promises of God. Sometimes that response does lead to "feel good" feelings. And yet it is the response that is important. I would like to encourage you to look at all the readings around Holy Week from that perspective, how do people respond to what is happening, and how is that reflected in their decisions? On Sunday we will look at the Triumphant Entry in Jerusalem, or Palm Sunday, and ask the question: What is my response to seeing Jesus walk toward me?

I would also like to take this time to ask you to check your calendar and see if you can come out on Saturday April 12 at 8 am to help us with **Easter Egg Hunt**, we could use some extra hands in the kitchen and craft area.
