

A letter from Lead Pastor, Bo Mircea

Do you know Titus? Yes, the Titus that Paul speaks about as being his most trusted friend and worker in God's vineyard. Do you know him? Do you know what he's about? What did he do, or what he had to do in his ministry among the people of Crete?

Bo, why are you asking all these questions? Well, in part because I was thinking about how little we think about people like Titus, who pop up here and there in the Bible, that we are not very familiar with. Yet their lives carry a lot of important lessons that can be applied to our daily lives. As we enter this new season of ministry here at 1st Pres, I will take time on Sunday mornings, at least for a while, to introduce to you (or reintroduce) some of these folks so together we can pray that the Lord will teach us what it means "to be a Christ follower" in today's world. This coming Sunday we are starting by looking at the Epistle to Titus, and I am praying that our hearts will be open to the words found in this letter.
