This is exactly what I mean when I say: The word of God is challenging. It will make us pause, make us think, and stir up emotions and varied responses. Please remember last week's sermon: 2 Timothy 3:16-17, "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work."

So while I am looking forward to Sunday worship, as I do every week, I am also praying that the Word will speak to all of us in a powerful and meaningful way that will lead all of us to good works.
